Keep your devices up to date with the latest security updates and install only trusted apps. Most attacks use known vulnerabilities.




Beware of free applications and software!

Think before you click on a link and open a file you received. The file despite looking legitimate could be malware.



Control your curiosity!

BUY ONLINE WITH CONFIDENCE

Don't buy from websites you don't know or don't have any feedback on.



Check if the site has trust seals (CONFIO, for example); uses https. Prefer to use temporary credit cards to make payments.
